Looking Towards Graduation

Freshman year

Start keeping your transcript during your freshman year. It is a lot easier than trying to pull everything together as a senior. Mars Hill does not have an official transcript. It is up to the individual to keep the grades and create a transcript. Samples have been provided.

This is also a good time to start keeping a record of volunteer jobs, community service, work experience, etc. to have ready for college and scholarship applications.

Sophomore year

Sophomores are eligible to take the PSAT although it is not necessary. The results only count your junior year. The PSAT is always given the third Saturday in October. Contact your local school early in September to register.

Sophomores are also eligible for the Governor's School for the Arts. Students can apply in many fields including architecture, creative writing, dance, drama, instrumental music, musical theatre, new media, visual art and vocal music. For information about the Governor's School for the Arts go to www.kentuckygsa.com late summer or early in September.

Junior year

Junior year is the time to take the PSAT test even if you took it your sophomore year. The PSAT is always given the <u>third Saturday in October</u>. Contact your local school early in September to register.

Junior year is also the time to take your first ACT and SAT. It is easy to register online for both of these tests. For dates and registration go to www.actstudent.org for the ACT and www.collegeboard.com for the SAT.

After taking the PSAT, you will be inundated with material from colleges. Go online to a particular college's website. There is a wealth of information there, including applications and scheduling visits.

Attend a college fair. The local high schools usually have one in early October.

Juniors are also eligible for the Governor's School for the Arts. For information about the Governor's School for the Arts go to www.kentuckygsa.com late summer or early in September.

Your junior year is also the time to apply for the Governor's Scholar Program. For information about the Governor's Scholarship Program go to www.kygsp.org late summer or early September.

Senior year

Not happy with your tests' scores? You still have time to take them again. See websites above.

Make a master copy of work resume, extracurricular activities, community service, etc. Every college and scholarship application asks for this information. If you have all the info in one place that you can refer to each time, it makes the application process faster.

Attend a college fair to get information.
