

Kentucky Minimum Graduation Requirements for Students Entering High School in 2019-2020 and Thereafter

<u>704 KAR 3:305</u>, Kentucky's new minimum high school graduation requirements, became effective on April 5, 2019. However, <u>Senate Bill 158</u> (2020) requires changes be made to state and local graduation requirements for students who entered high school in the 2019-2020 school year and thereafter. Other Graduation Requirements:

- Pass state-mandated civics test
- (Beginning in 2020-2021) Successfully complete a course or program in financial literacy
- Receive instruction in essential workplace ethics
- Demonstrate competency in technology

Other Considerations:

- Development of Individual Learning Plan (grades 6-12)
- CPR Training in Health, PE or JROTC course
